MASTER FACILITATORS

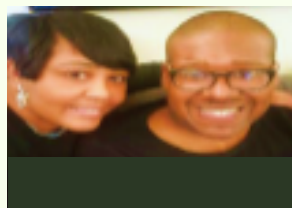
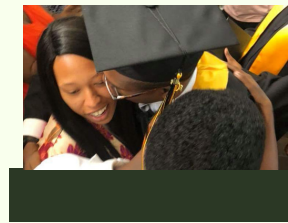
We fill the family support gap during team meetings. Our systems of care approach and individualized planning ensures a focus on the voices of families who may be involved with various service agencies.
